### LOW VISION SERVICES:

- Comprehensive vision assessment, information about eye conditions and the implications for visual performance.
- Enhancement of reading ability, efficiency and accuracy of print (including magnification assessment)
- Optimisation of vision for general activities of daily life
- Strategies to assist with visual fatigue
- Management of glare sensitivity
- Lighting assessment to tailor lighting for near tasks and at home
- Family education to help understand their loved one's vision loss

### SPECIALISED LOW VISION SERVICES:

- Eccentric Viewing Training
- Scanning Training to develop visual field awareness
- Null point training using biofeedback technology.
- Paediatric visual functional assessment (including understanding of vision loss and strategies to support learning and development)
- Functional vision assessment and intervention of neurological visual impairment (i.e. cerebral visual impairment, cerebral palsy, epilepsy, acquired brain injury, stroke, Parkinson's Disease and Multiple Sclerosis)
- Functional vision assessment and intervention for children with sensory integration challenges (such as: Autism (ASD), ADHD and auditory processing disorder)
